

Dental students from across the Asia Pacific region forged new friendships while learning from dentists and leaders within the dental industry through various lectures and workshops. Other highlights of the event included the Oral and Poster Scientific Research Competition, Dental Quiz, Soap Carving Competition, and Cultural Night.

Mid-Year Meeting Vietnam

12th - 15th December 2019

APDSA Mid-Year Meeting 2019 was held in Ho Chi Minh City, one of the biggest cities in Vietnam. With the theme "Give Smiles, Change Life", APDSA Vietnam being the host of the event has brought together dental students from across the Asia Pacific region to be a part of multiple exciting activities including the Lend-A-Hand Project, dental clinical workshop, cooking class, city tour, and food tour. 5th June 2020

26th - 27th June 2021

2nd International Webinar 2022

20th August

The 2nd International Webinar, focused on crucial topics in oral and maxillofacial surgery, including odontectomy, tumors, and cysts. The webinar featured esteemed speakers such as Dr. Fredy Mardiantoro from Brawijaya University, Indonesia, who discussed odontectomy, and Prof. Dr. Riaz Ahmed Warraich from the University of Lahore, Pakistan, who covered tumors and cysts. Moderated by experts from Indonesia and Pakistan, the event was free and open to dental students, dentists, residents, and specialists. Participants also had the opportunity to earn international certificates by engaging through social media and attending the session. The event was a collaborative effort between APDSA Malaysia, the University of Lahore, and Dens Up Corporation.

47th APDSA Annual Congress Cambodia

27th - 28th August 2021

The Asia Pacific Dental Students Association (APDSA) Annual Congress is a yearly event organised to bring together dental students from APDSA member nations in the region. Every year, over 300 students, professors, and graduate doctors from more than 13 countries in the region attend the congress, with the hosting of the congress rotated amongst member countries. The 47th APDSA Annual Congress was hosted by APDSA Cambodia and was previously planned to be held in 2020. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the event was postponed to 2021 and was the first virtual annual congress. The highlighted events included webinars, dental quizzes, and cultural night.

48th APDSA Annual Congress Taiwan

1st- 4th September 2022

The Asia Pacific Dental Students Association (APDSA) Annual Congress is a yearly event organised to bring together dental students from APDSA member nations in the region. After online events were ingrained during the pandemic era, the Annual Congress of 2022 was held in Taiwan, with participation from Malaysia, Thailand, Indonesia, Hong Kong, and Pakistan. The 2022 Annual Congress offered a hybrid of online and offline activities. Offline participants experienced city tours, optional tours, lectures, workshops, dental quizzes and debates, cultural evenings, and after parties, while online participants joined lectures, dental quizzes and debates only.

Share Amazing Work (SAW Competition)

October-December 2022

The "Share Amazing Work" (SAW) dental photography contest, organized by APDSA Malaysia, invited undergraduate dental students from across Malaysia to showcase their skills in dental photography, with the theme "Direct Restoration." Participants demonstrated their ability to capture detailed and aesthetically focused dental work, reflecting the importance of photography in modern dentistry. The event, with a registration fee of RM 10, provided an exciting opportunity for students to enhance their photography expertise while sharing their outstanding work with peers and professionals in the field.

OSCE Study Group

14th-15th January 2023

The OSCE Study Group, was a valuable learning opportunity for dental students preparing for their Objective Structured Clinical Examinations (OSCE). Conducted via Zoom, the peer-assisted study group offered participants a chance to engage in mock OSCE stations, followed by discussions and feedback sessions with tutors and supervising doctors. The sessions also included practical tips and role-playing exercises designed to enhance students' performance in OSCE-type exams. This interactive learning experience was highly appreciated by participants, who benefited from the supportive and collaborative environment.

49th APDSA Annual Congress Indonesia 2023

1st-5th August 2023

The APDSA Annual Congress is an important event that brings together dental students, professors, and graduate doctors from across the Asia Pacific region. With participants from more than 17 countries, the congress offers a platform for over 400 attendees to exchange knowledge, ideas, and foster professional relationships. The APDSA Annual Congress 2023 was held in Bali, Indonesia featuring a variety of events, including scientific research competitions, seminars, workshops, and cultural activities. The event was packed with exciting activities designed to enhance both academic and social connections among future dental professionals across member countries.

Workshop & Lecture Series

17th December 2023

The workshop & lecture series featured across various dental disciplines. Prof. Seow Liang Lin discussed managing complications fixed Dr. in prosthodontics, while Dr. Ha Kien Oon covered the evolution of dental implants. A/P Dr. Firdaus Bin Hariri and team led a suturing workshop, focusing on precision techniques, and Dr. Noor Hayati Binti Azami introduced advanced root canal methods using ProTaper Gold. Finally, Associate Professor Dr. Noor Azlin Yahya simplified composite veneer techniques, guiding participants in shade selection, bonding, and finishing for naturallookina restorations. These sessions enhanced attendees' skills in prosthodontics, implantology, suturing, endodontics, and cosmetic dentistry.

Mid-Year Meeting & Lend-a-Hand Project

December 2023

The APDSA Mid-Year Meeting (MYM) & Lend-A-Hand Project (LHP) 2023 brings together dental students from 16 member countries to engage in cultural exchange, teamwork, and community service. Hosted in Malaysia after a 9-year gap, the event focuses on skill-building through workshops, lectures, and social activities, fostering global perspectives and social responsibility. Beyond enhancing dental knowledge, MYM & LHP encourages students to form lasting professional connections, broaden their understanding of global healthcare, and contribute to meaningful community development.

OSCE Study Group 2024

27th April 2024

The OSCE Study Group, organized by APDSA MD, is a peer-assisted learning platform designed to help Year 4 and 5 dental students prepare for the Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE). Taking place on 27th April 2024, this study group will be conducted via Zoom and features role-play exercises, tips and tricks for OSCE preparation, and mock OSCE stations with supervising doctors. The session provides a focused environment for students to enhance their clinical skills and gain expert insights, ensuring they are well-prepared for their exams.

28th June 2024

The APDSA Webinar Series 3.0 on flexible dentures, led by A/P Dr. Lim Ghee Seong, an expert in restorative dentistry, provided an insightful session designed for dental professionals and students aiming to expand their knowledge of the latest advancements in flexible denture technology. Participants had the opportunity to learn directly from an experienced specialist, gaining valuable insights into the field and receiving an E-Certificate for their participation. It was a great chance for attendees to enhance their expertise in restorative dentistry.
